## **Griffiths Garage Isolation Service**

As part of our efforts to support local residents who are self-isolating, we are expanding our morning delivery service to include grocery shops.

### **What you need to do**

In order to use the delivery service, please return the new customer form and set up a local account, or contact us at [accounts@griffithsgarage.co.uk](mailto:accounts@griffithsgarage.co.uk) or on 01547540223.

Local account bills are sent monthly by post or by e-mail.

### **How to use the service**

Our delivery service goes out daily at 7am each morning 364 days of the year.

Please telephone or e-mail us with your order by 12pm for delivery after 7am the next day. Our telephone lines are extremely busy, please consider asking for the help of a Parish Council volunteer to submit orders via e-mail.

### **Delivery fees**

Grocery deliveries are free of charge. Fair use applies, please do not have us deliver single items each day unless the matter is urgent.

Newspaper deliveries cost 0.20pence per day (0.60 pence on Sundays), plus the cost of any newspapers or magazines.

### **Stock availability and supply to customers**

Like many retailers, we are struggling to maintain supply of key lines such as toilet roll, pasta and paracetamol. We understand that the supply chain will begin to catch up fully from next week (w/c 23<sup>rd</sup> March).

Our suppliers of staples such as bread, milk and eggs are all from Herefordshire and Shropshire and all have confirmed that the supply chain is robust and can easily handle the current surge in demand.

We are doing everything we can to bring currently non-stocked products back into store.

### **Mobile Post Office Service**


At the time of going to print the Mobile Post Office Service is still operational.
