We hope some of our regular stall holders will be there.

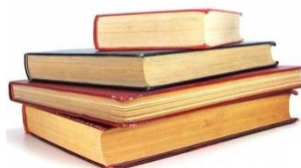
Please remember that you **must not** enter the Community Centre or the Reading Room if you or anyone in your household has COVID-19
