Do you have apples going spare? Leintwardine Ciderfects will be holding a Covid-secure Community Apple Pressing on October 17th. You are invited to bring your apples along to the front garden of the **Old Vicarage 12 Watling Street** be turned into apple juice or converted into cider. All apples need to be pre-washed and sorted (removing damaged parts). If you'd like to take juice away please bring sterilised plastic or glass containers. Juice will be available at 50 pence per litre.

All proceeds will contribute to local good causes and to maintaining the Community's pressing equipment.

If you have more apples/juice than you need any contribution to the community supplies will be gratefully received. These will be mulled for use at the Frost Fair in support of St Mary Magdalen's Church and other local charities, and at other local events.
